

Theme - "Roseville Schools and Education Today"

Roseville Area Schools is an anti-racist district, one that welcomes all students to be their authentic selves. In today's diverse educational landscape, addressing the unique needs of students requires more than a one-size-fits-all approach. This presentation delves into the intersectionality of race, gender identity, and educational ability among other topics, and explores how these factors collectively influence student experiences and outcomes.

Dr. Jenny Loeck assumed the role of superintendent of Roseville Area Schools in July 2021. For more than 27 years, Dr. Loeck has worked in public education in various roles with increasing responsibility, including as a physical education and health teacher, associate principal and activities director, principal, and assistant superintendent.

Dr. Loeck was instrumental in initiating the AVID program in Roseville Area Schools, which supports students who have the potential of becoming first-generation college students, and is committed to advancing policies and practices that support equity and remove barriers for students of color, English learners, and students receiving special education services.

Dr. Loeck is a longtime resident and member of the Roseville community where she resides with her family, including an elementary student who attends Roseville Area Schools. Niceta Thomas is a lifelong Educational Strategist who has a demonstrated history of working in the education management industry, by prioritizing students-first in all decision-making, while dedicating her career to eliminating inequities. In July of 2024 Niceta became the Executive Director of Student Services for the district. She has spent 20+ years in the field of special education.

Niceta currently resides in Woodbury, MN with her husband and 3 children, one of whom attends Roseville Area Schools.
